Course Content

- RIIG002A Communicate in the workplace
- RIIG003A Contribute to quality work outcomes
- BSBCMN215A Participate in environmental work practices

Elective Units

- RIIG004A Conduct local risk control
- RIIG2001A Plan and organize work

What will this entitle me to do if I am successful in RII10106 Certificate I in Resources and Infrastructure Operations?

If competent (you have been assessed as having the required knowledge and skills) you will develop

- Industry readiness which will enable you to comply with the high safety standards and expectations associated with the resources and infrastructure industries.
- Employability skills which will expose the essential skills in communication, teamwork, problem solving, planning, organizing and using initiative.
- An understanding of site procedures and learn how to work with and use relevant industry policies and procedures.

Location

This course is designed to be delivered online; therefore you can study in the comfort of your desired location. You will have access to your trainer via email or telephone, who will support you where necessary and provide you with assistance.

Assessment

RII10106 Certificate I in Resources and Infrastructure Operations is a Nationally recognised Qualification, therefore there is a number of assessment tasks that you will be required to complete to meet the required criteria/standard.
